### SOUTH32 LEADERSHIP VISITS WORSLEY ALUMINA

Members of the South32 Board joined with senior management in a visit to the South32 Worsley Alumina refinery, near Collie, earlier this month.

The site visit was the first time that members of the South32 Board had visited one of the company's assets since it became an independent, stand-alone company in May 2015. The establishment of South32 followed a demerger from BHP Billiton, resulting in the creation of Australia's newest mining company.

Visitors to Worsley included South32 Board Chairman David Crawford, five other board members, Chief Operating Officer for the Australian Region Ricus Grimbeek and Chief Legal Officer Nicole Duncan.

A week earlier, South32 Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Graham Kerr toured Worsley's Boddington Bauxite Mine.

"The visits by our Board and CEO are clear demonstrations of South32's commitment to safe, efficient and reliable operations across the organisation," South32 Worsley Alumina Asset President Michael Rix said.

Worsley is an important asset in the South32 group, which has operations across five countries and 11 commodities. It is headquartered in Perth.

South32 has an 86 per cent stake in Worsley, Japan Alumina Associates (Australia) 10 per cent and Sojitz Alumina 4 per cent. Worsley has been mining bauxite, refining alumina and exporting it to the world since 1984.
