Modification to Dendrobium Underground Coal Mine Development Consent (DA 60-03-2001): Dendrobium Power Supply Upgrade

Please find attached an application under s75W of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979 to modify the Dendrobium Underground Coal Mine Development Consent (DA 60-03-2001) to include the upgrade of existing power supply at Dendrobium Mine.

Dendrobium Mine is currently supplied electricity from a 33kV overhead power line that originates from Bluescope Steel (BSL). South 32 Illawarra Coal propose to migrate from this private network supply to a local network supplier, a 11kV supply from Endeavour Energy. This requires a new 2MVA 11/6.6kV kiosk style transformer on Illawarra Coal land adjacent to Dendrobium Pit Top Switchyard.

The Dendrobium Mine site is listed on the Wollongong Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2009 as “Nebo Colliery” (Item #7104), as an item of local heritage significance. Previous heritage assessments have defined the existing electrical switchyard site, which is proposed to be replaced, as an item of Moderate to Low heritage significance.
