

INVESTING IN BODDINGTON – PAST, PRESENT AND ONGOING

Supporting Boddington is about long term partnerships and backing the people and organisations who help the community thrive.

We have worked alongside local groups, clubs and services to support community identified projects across education, health, sport, arts, environment and local events. This includes partnerships with organisations such as the Lions Club of Boddington, Boddington Arts Council, Teach Learn Grow, Boddington Progress Group, Boddington Shears, Boddington Swimming and Golf Clubs, the Boddington–Wandering Target Club, Peel Harvey Catchment Council, Boddington District High School, the Community Resource Centre, the Boddington Community Newsletter, Quindanning Picnic Races and the Peel District Cycling Club.

In addition to these community partnerships, we continue to work with the Shire of Boddington through strategic investments and event partnerships that support community wellbeing, liveability and long term planning.

Together, this support represents hundreds of thousands of dollars invested locally, with a strong focus on initiatives shaped and led by the community and designed to deliver lasting benefit for the region.

That commitment continues today, with funding directed through open Community Grants rounds that allow local organisations to put forward ideas that matter to them.

Applications for our current Community Grants round are closing soon, and local groups, clubs and community organisations are encouraged to apply for funding for projects that will benefit the Boddington, Wandering and Williams communities.

Projects may include improvements to community facilities, support for local events, wellbeing initiatives or resources that help volunteers do what they do best.

COMMUNITY LIAISON COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Community Liaison Committee (CLC) met on 17 February 2026, bringing together community representatives and South32 to share updates, discuss priorities and raise local matters.

Key discussion points from the meeting included:

- Leadership update: Introduction of Matt Daley, incoming CEO, who will replace Graham Kerr.
- Bushfire impacts: Discussion on the recent fires affecting Boddington and Wandering, including the financial and in kind support provided to assist recovery.
- Environmental update: Progress from the spring environmental survey, updates from the Kings Park Orchid Program, and ongoing feral pig trapping activities.
- Innovation and monitoring: An update on the Fauna Monitoring Innovation Challenge (BioTrack) and its role in advancing environmental monitoring approaches.
- Projects and operations: Updates on the Nullaga Project and confirmation that Lower Hotham Road demobilisation has now been completed.
- Governance: Review of the CLC Terms of Reference.
- Industry and recognition: Information on the Chamber of Minerals and Energy of Western Australia (CMEWA) 2026 Women in Resources Awards.
- Community support: A reminder and discussion on the current Community Grants Program.
