Amaroo Primary School operates one of only two full-time school canteens in the entire South West region and used their grant to update their old, unreliable pie warmer.

The Breakfast Club, run by volunteers and supported by the P&C, offers free nutritious meals to ensure every student can start their day with the energy needed to learn and thrive but the canteen staff have been unable to keep up with the increasing demand for this service.

The new commercial-grade pie warmer with modern safety features and higher volume capacity will directly benefit the school's 335+ students and the broader community.
