### **August 2016 Worsley Update**

#### **FY16 business performance**

- Safety – fostered culture where employees feel able to report injuries and incidents
- Production & costs – Worsley Alumina record annual production in FY16 of 4.6 Mt; reduced unit costs to US\$221 per tonne.
- Water supply investigations on going
- Proposed level crossing on Lower Hotham Road will be formally lodged in October

#### **Water health - community project**

- Multi-year partnership to restore waterway health to Tunbridge Gully and Hotham River
- More than \$75,000 committed to assist with the removal of invasive weeds

#### **Community update**

- Community Investment Strategy review expected to be complete in October
- Grants are now open to applicants at any time offering greater flexibility
